





PLAYER IDENTIFICATION:

The purpose of the ECNL Selection Program is to identify, develop, and reward the top players in the country.

Conference Selection Programs (CSPs):

- Approximately 600 players across 10 events.
- Players are selected based on performance in ECNL competitions and recommendations from coaches.
- Each ECNL CSP occurs over two days and includes training sessions and matches.
- All players receive Nike training gear.
- The ECNL covers the cost of participation, excluding travel costs when necessary.

ECNL National Training Camp (NTC):

- 130 players across 2 camps.
- Players train and compete with the best athletes in the country and learn from the country's top coaches.
- There is no cost to players aside from travel to and from the camp.
- Lodging, meals and training gear are provided by the ECNL and Nike.



ECNL PLAYER AWARDS

ECNL All-Conference Teams:

- Awarded at the U15, U16, U17 and U18/U19 age groups.
- Conference Player of the Year at each of the four age groups.

ECNL All-American Teams:

Awarded to 30 players in each of the U16, U17 and U18/19 age groups.

ECNL Player of the Year:

• Awarded to the top player in the ECNL.

*All Awards announced and published in June and July across the ECNL and multiple other soccer networks.



ECNL NATIONAL SELECTION GAMES

The ECNL National Selection Game Series provides an all-star atmosphere for players at national events to compete in front of their clubmates, college coaches and US Soccer Youth National Team scouts, and in front of the world on livestream. Thirty of the nation's best players at each national event are selected to compete.








STRENGTH IN NUMBERS: ECNL ALUMS IN THE COLLEGE GAME


Each year an average of 1,200 student-athletes, approximately 90% of the graduating class, commit to playing collegiate soccer and further their playing career.







ECNL ALUMS OWNED THE COLLEGE GAME IN 2019
